What is Tarot:

The Tarot is a pictorial textbook of ageless wisdom, a journey of self-discovery and understanding leading to wisdom.

Tarot can answer everyday life questions and much more.

Tarot has been used in mystery schools, lodges and so-called secret societies in order to study old traditions, symbols and self.

Practical instructions for the cards:

Tarot strengthens our intuition and clairvoyance.

Some people say that they don't want to know the future.

The future is not set. You can use tarot to see tendencies and make changes for the better.

If you know you are going in the direction of what you don't want, you can change and go in the direction of what you do want.

You now have 78 friends that are more than willing to help you in every way, with every major decision. Just relax and ask. Tarot will help you to improve your attitude and understanding your soul. The cards have traditional colors, elements and symbols that stimulate the subconscious. The subconscious will understand and act upon them in a positive manner.

About the cards:

The main cards are called the major arcana which means 'secret'.

There are 22 cards called trumps or key cards based on the Hebrew alphabet.

They represent the main forces or energies that we experience in life.

The small cards, sometimes called the minor arcana, give us exact explanations of specific states and situations.

There are also 16 court cards that usually represent real people, attitudes and behaviors.

It's possible to ask the cards any question, including how a particular person feels about you, or how things will develop with your career or spiritual path. Please to ask your question as specifically as possible. It's best to ask your question out loud.

The major arcana starts with 0 (the fool) and ends with 21 (the universe).

The small cards or minor arcana starts with aces.

They consist of four elements.

Wands = Fire (energy)

Cups = Water (feeling)

Swords = Air (thinking)

Disks = Earth (physical)

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There are also four court cards, called royal courts or personality cards.
On top you find the name of the card and underneath the energy or principle.

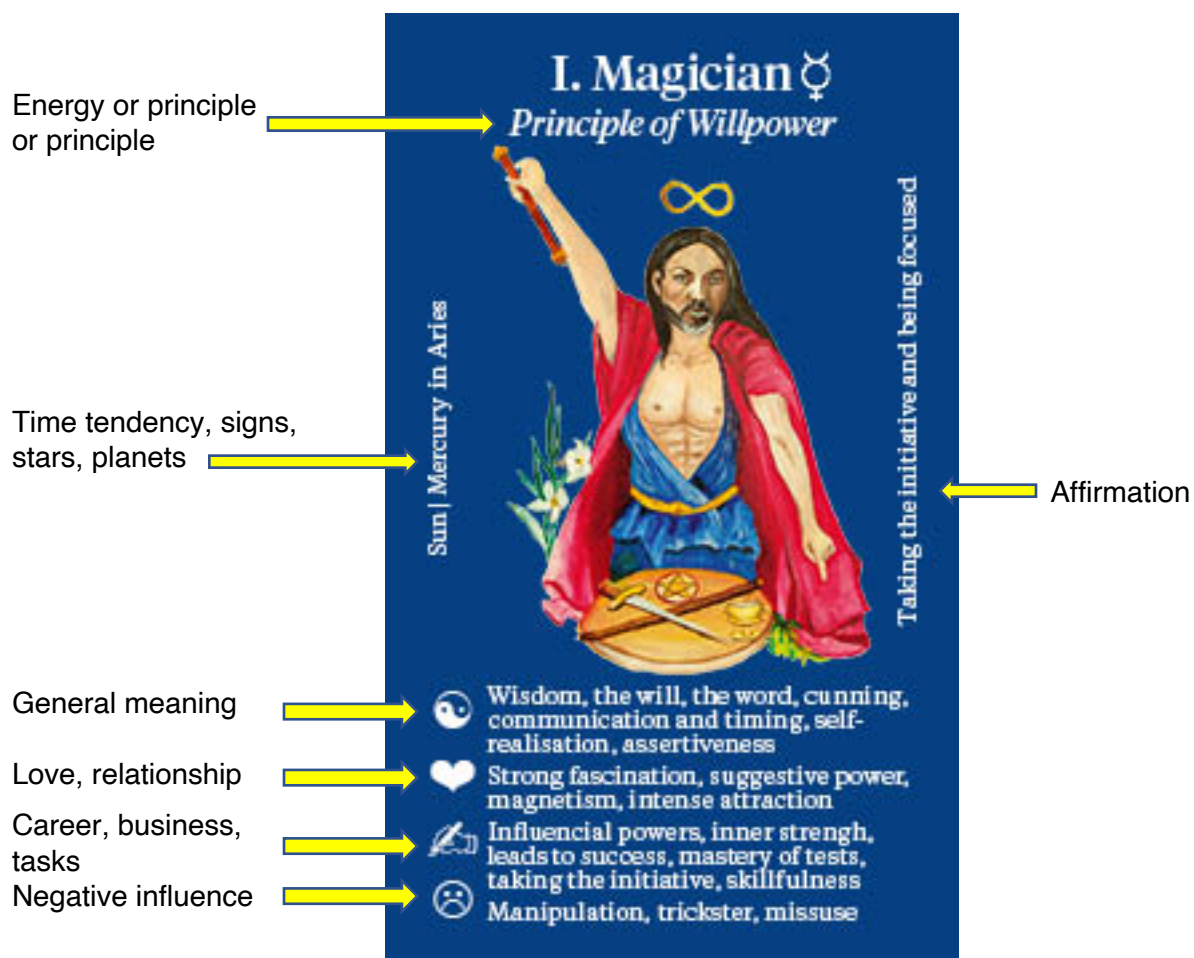
In the middle of the left side you will find the time tendencies, planets or astrological signs.
On the right side you will find affirmations (except the court cards)
On all small cards you will find an explanation such as positive, negative or neutral.

This Symbol ☺ stands for the general meaning.

The second symbol ❤️ stands for relationships, love and emotions.

The third symbol 🖐️ stands for your job, career, business or tasks.

The fourth symbol ☹️ stands for possible negative influences.



The four court cards:

King or Knight

Queen

Prince

Princess

Fire: Creativity, energy, leadership, optimism, passion and action.

Correspondence: Aries, Leo, Sagittarius.

Water: Emotional world, inner orientation, empathy and love.

Correspondence: Cancer, Scorpion, Pisces.

Air: Mental power, thinking, ideas.

Correspondence: Aquarius, Gemini, Libra.

Earth: Material world, social developments, practical skills and reliability.

Correspondence: Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn.

The four elements also relate or correspond to the months of the year.

This gives an indication of the time tendency that the cards are suggesting when it's being asked for.

Of course, you should use and rely on your intuition. Practice makes perfect.

Connected to the star signs you can also relate the corresponding months more easily. This explains the quality of time that the cards are indicating. The exact interpretation of time is to be made in the overall view of all cards laid out in the spread. Here you should rely on your intuition, which can be better learned through practice.

- Pay close attention to your question, because it has the highest priority!
- Take in the colors, images and symbols on the cards.
- Use the bullet points and let your inspiration run free.

You will be able to check the results of your spreads and find the connection in your life. I would suggest writing down or taking a picture of the whole spread.

Supplementary card descriptions - the major arcana

0. Fool - Pisces Transit Aries - Spring (timeless)

Principle of the First Impulse

The fool represents the first impulse. You enter a new phase of life or encounter a situation with enthusiasm without any expectations or prior knowledge and are full of ideas. In the material realm one behaves innocently, unless they perceive the impulse in time, and implement it immediately.

The fool encourages one to open to the possibility of new adventures and experiences and embrace them without fear. The fool also reminds us to have fun and to return to some of our childhood innocence. The fool connects the highest (spirit) with the lowest (earth)

He contains within him everything, being born out of spirit, and yet lacks worldly experience and depth.

The fool trusts in life and expects his path to be a happy and rewarding one. There is faith in the Gods to see him through and a complete absence of fear.

Sometimes the fool is seen as too carefree.

Key words: openness, trust, ready to take a risk, courage to stand your ground, independence, creativity, great potential, possibility to take a quantum leap, listening to the hearts voice.

I. Magician - Sun / Mercury / Mercury in Aries

Principle of Willpower

He represents wisdom, the will and the power of the word that creates the world through directed activity. Where the fool is inexperienced, the magician uses his knowledge and willpower and achieves his goals.

The magician is card number one and is sometimes called the magus. He is usually depicted as a powerful adept. A master of the elements, he is able to shift events in his favor, to make the world change around him according to his will. He is duality. He represents both truth and falsehood, wisdom and folly. This is why the magus can also be represented as the trickster.

The card represents the will, wisdom and the word.

The Magician has no conscience, he uses all tools, all methods to arrive at his goal.

The temptation to misuse his talents is great. His ability and skill lend him superiority and power.

He moves on the border between white and black magic. In general, the magician energy moves quickly.

Key words: communication, flexibility, brilliance, will-power, directing your will, creative visualization, manifesting desires.

II. High Priestess - Moon / Moon in Scorpio

Principle of Intuition

With lunar consciousness she moves the level between sleep and wakefulness, where the so-called 'reality' as a form of experience in dreaming is being prepared. It indicates the benefits of intuition and divine wisdom.

Number two

Gimel=Camel

Astrological attributions: The Moon

Meaning: To connect and be more confident with your intuition/feminine side.

Your spiritual guide is calling you. In times of darkness where you may be lost, look to your inner guide and connect with your intuition. The magician generates his own power, the priestess draws upon the forces of life itself.

Key words: Access to intuitive powers, healing, independence, inner equilibrium, increased self-confidence, mystery, intuition, spiritual insight, divination, spirit guides, discovering your own truth

III. Empress Venus in Taurus / May

Principle of Motherhood

It is through them that the highest spiritual and lowest material qualities find their expression. It represents the source of all life. The empress has unlimited power to create something new, but also can initiate the dissolution of old structures.

Astrological attribution: Venus

Daleth: Door

She has the highest spiritual values with the lowest material qualities.

Meaning: Birth (pregnancy) fertility, being in touch with the beauty of your life.

Describes an empathetic and caring person in touch with universal love/spirit.

Reminding us that spirituality is expressed from the heart, not from the head.

The need to recognize that the doorway to spirit is love and is the channel for God or the (Holy Guardian Angel). The Empress has a connection with nature and life.

Key words: Beauty, love, motherliness, femininity, wisdom, connection between spirit and matter, inner and outer wealth, creativity

IV. Emperor - March 21st - April 20th / Aries, Sun in Capricorn, April

Principle of Rulership

As the ruler of order and structure, he stands for stability and enforcement, but is stubborn and inflexible. His intellect only accepts what is measurable and controllable.

Astrological attribution: Aries

Tzaddi = fish hook

The emperor symbolizes leadership, responsibility, self-control, discipline and focus.

We must take responsibility for our life and actions. There is a tendency to take on responsibility for others.

A natural organizer working from a point of fairness with others, the emperor prefers to be the boss or the leader of others rather than a follower.

Key words: pioneer, discoverer, leader, creative wisdom, urge for action, adventurousness, new beginning, fatherhood, authority.

V. Hierophant - April 21st - May 20th / Taurus

Principle of Learning and Teaching

It stands for the world of faith, deep trust and inner certainty.

This points out hidden truths and teaches us to experience the higher meaning that we can see in everything.

Hebrew association: Vau = nail

Astrological attributions: Taurus the bull.

Meaning: Traditional religious teachings or learning the fundamentals of a subject.

Indicates the need to follow rules and regulations or traditions in your life.

Also indicates the need to follow tried and tested means of success.

Becoming a mentor to others and teaching.

Marriage or a position in a company where there is an established order.

The Hierophant is also the search for the hidden truth. Can be a little sadistic.

Key words: Spiritual master, teacher, advisor, initiate, inner guide, spiritual father, highest transformation.

VI. Lovers - May 21st - June 19th / Gemini

Principle of Free Decision

This card stands for sexuality and human love with all their contradictions. It unites opposites, decision-making is required.

Hebrew: Zayin = sword

Astrological attribution: Gemini

Each partner in a relationship mirrors the mental and spiritual condition of the other.

What you feel is missing in yourself you see in the other. All opposites are important. With love comes jealousy, with harmony comes disharmony, with unity comes separation, etc.

Meaning: The meanings of the card centers around opposites.

The need to look carefully at all angles of a situation before making a decision.

Mutual attraction, a sexual connection that goes beyond just the physical. Both partners need to know each other and themselves for this to work in balance and harmony.

The choice we have is a major life decision. Loving ourselves is the first step to universal love.

We must live every moment as if it were the only one.

Rejoice and celebrate the soul within us, rather than fighting the reflection that the rest of the world sees.

Key words: Choice/decision, duality, opposites, love, attraction, connection, union of opposites through love.

VII. Chariot - June 21st - July 20th / Cancer

Principle of Conquest

This card stands for a determined departure and for the detachment from old concepts with newly gained self-confidence. This opens up a completely new worldview.

Hebrew: Cheth= Fence or field

Astrological attribution: Cancer

Meaning: Having the courage to act and follow your goals.

Victory over adversity. We have come through a difficult period and overcome it.

We need to focus on self-discipline and internal strengths to follow our goals.

To move towards new and higher goals but remaining centered and protective of oneself.

This card generally refers to imminent new beginnings. A journey, new relationship, new job, living situation etc.

Key words: A new beginning, change for the good, meditation, spiritual path.

VIII. Balance - September 23rd - October 22nd / Libra

Principle of Justice

This card stands for the results of our actions, good or bad. It shows us the clear and objective perceptions and guides us by finding harmony through the mastery of reality.

The sense of fairness and balance are at a peak. It is time for making reasonable decisions and taking responsibility for oneself. Be aware not to be controlled by emotions. Legal affairs go well and marriage or divorce could be a consideration.

Hebrew: Lamed

Astrological attribution: Libra

Key words: Justice, legal affairs, balance and equilibrium, truth, fairness, responsibility, accountability, integrity, dignity, agreements, consulting a lawyer, checking legal documents, seeking fairness through clarity, trial outcomes, justice system.

IX. Hermit - August 22nd - September 23rd / Virgo

Principle of Inner Guidance

This card stands for searching the truth in ourselves and in the souls of human beings. Through inner peace, silence or meditation one reaches out to clearer contemplation. Even in the darkness the Hermit is on our side. This card also tells, this is a time of withdrawal and going within oneself to find illumination, wisdom and enlightenment. With meditation and self-reflection one will find the right answer and make the right decision. In relations it can mean that one feels lonely, but there is an opportunity to realize that personal power can make life a positive experience.

Hebrew: Yod (hand)

Astrological attribution: Virgo

Key Words: Isolation, introspection, private self-reflection, seeking enlightenment, spiritual experiences, meditation, privacy, home study, withdrawing from society, self-exploration, therapy/counseling

X. Wheel of Fortune - Jupiter

Principle of Eternal Change

This card indicates the acceptance of destiny and chance. The ever-rotating wheel into the future, the presence of creation from the past and the moment of now in transformation. It is more about the willingness to adjust to the changes than the power of outer influences or circumstances. Within the wheel of life, we are learning to understand karmic connections. On one hand we have to accept the permanent changes. On the other, we need to recognize and deal with our destiny. Fortunately, the change is usually for the better. With time and understanding we will transform the lower into the higher and have a promising future.

Hebrew: Kaph (Palm of hand)

Astrological attribution: Jupiter

Key words: changes, turning point, fate, ups and downs, opportunity, life cycles, winning games, chances, good times

XI. Lust - July 23rd - August 22nd / Lion

Principle of Passion

This is not only about strength but also about joy, and consciously experiencing and accepting it. We encounter all our instincts as well as animal powers up to divine drunkenness, some of which have to be tamed, loved and used in a targeted manner. It is also an experience of challenging times with the focus on great passion. The attempt to be in control of the hot temper and the awareness of our actions can help avoid any dramatic performances driven by instinct. Life is testing you, especially when you present your views in public. Stay positive and turn passion into love for your loved ones. If you are looking for a partner your magnetism is extremely vibrant.

Hebrew: A serpent

Astrological attribution: Leo the lion

Meaning: Relates to having the desire (passion) for a particular situation.

Engaging with life to the fullest.

Accepting our instinctive/carnal/animal nature or things that are not usually considered spiritual.

Not repressing them but making sure that we have conscious control of them.

Sexual union/passionate relationship with sexual/emotional intensity.

Using courage to follow our passions that serve for our highest good.

Lust in its higher sense is the bliss of experiencing integration with something higher than yourself. It can relate to the intense attraction between polar opposites.

Lust is also connected to the sexual act and therefore creation and life. But it's also very much about death and dissolving our identity into something higher.

This card is a representation of divine intoxication, divine ecstasy, divine madness.

Key words: Passion, strength, talent, integration of animalistic energies, overcoming old fears and conditions.

XII. Hanged man - Water / Pisces

Principle of Sacrifice

The hanged man indicates a very drastic outside influence resulting in forced immobility. This includes the opportunity to recognize the big picture and to redefine our worldview. Stagnation and sacrifice are experienced as suffering.

Number twelve

Hebrew: Mem = The ocean

Astrological attribution: Neptune/ Saturn

Full surrender to the higher self,

Freedom from narrow-mindedness and dogma.

“Not my Will, but thy Will be done, for thy Will is also mine.”

The Hanged Man deals with sacrifice, delays and waiting.

He is vulnerable, his attitude is: Whatever will be will be. He is giving in to his destiny.

Key words: End of a situation or relationship which is stuck.

Letting go, giving up, surrendering, learning to see in a new way, the necessity of breaking through old behavior patterns.

XIII. Death - October 23rd - November 21st / Scorpio

Principle of Transformation

The encounter with the natural event of becoming and passing includes dissolution. This does not have to be exclusively painful but can also be perceived as relieving and liberating.

Hebrew: Nun = Fish

Astrological attribution: Scorpio

Meaning: Dying/dissolving/disintegration.

It could be a structure we have created, a pattern, habit, or way of thinking about ourselves or the world.

This is necessary for new beginnings and transformation in our life.

A period of great transformation and facing your darkest fears.

As a rule, the Death card does not mean physical death, it generally points to radical external transformation. The act of letting go, difficult as it may be, will liberate you.

Death has two parts. Destroying and tearing down and freeing you from old bonds which have become confining.

Key words: Death and resurrection, transformation, becoming free of old ensnarement's, external changes.

XIV. Art - November 22nd - December 20th / Sagittarius

Principle of Temperance

By using selected combinations of certain forces, accurate mixtures are created to create a targeted effect.

Art or Balance

Hebrew: Samekh = Prop or crutch

Astrological attribution: Sagittarius

The whole card is about the unification of opposites.

Meaning: The theme of this card is about balance and harmony.

The Art card indicates that you are learning to bring about balance and moderation in your life. You have been able to take the middle road, avoiding extremes and maintaining a sense of calm.

This card also asks you to be patient so that you can act with conscious intent.

Key words: Unification of opposites, balance, inner change, transformation, alchemy, a quantum leap, creative power.

XV. Devil - December 21st - January 20th / Capricorn

Principle of Negativity

Due to extreme imbalance and an absolute disproportionality in everything, our unconscious self-encounters chaos and negativity.

Hebrew: Ayin = Eye

Astrological attribution: Capricorn

The Devil is another of the cards which are most often misunderstood.

To understand this card, you have to free yourself of all popular moral and superstitious ideas.

Every desire, every imprisonment, all-possessiveness leads only to frustration and suffering.

The Devil is represented by the God Pan, in the form of a white mountain-goat with powerful twisted horns.

The closer you get to your own truth, the more you see contradiction.

This brings about the need to see life in a different way.

This card teaches us to celebrate all aspects of life but not to become a slave to its pleasures.

Meaning: You feel restricted or imprisoned by life or a situation that appears out of your control, but you have far more influence over the situation than you realize.

We need to look at our addictions and attachments that are stopping us from enjoying life to the full.

We need to look at our impulse/compulsive behaviors, our addiction to drugs, sex, alcohol etc.

As long as we are not attached to the material, we can enjoy its paradox.

Keywords: Ego, manipulation, blind impulse, strong suggestive power, power hungry, wrong thinking, God upside down.

XVI. Tower - Pluto

Principle of Sudden Destruction

It stands for the experience of supposed security, which can mean sudden collapse of all forms in all areas. Usually this happens with the simultaneous arrival of excess energies of a catastrophic nature and forces us to build up new structures.

Hebrew: Pe pronounced (pay)= mouth.

Astrological attribution: Mars

Tower = Our limitation or ego.

The part of our awareness trapped in form and lower consciousness. The mental, emotional and physical bodies. The structure of identity that we have built up over our lifetime.

This is only a small part of who we are, and yet we see it as the totality. This limitation of our consciousness needs to be broken down.

The Tower is sudden change, chaos, end of plans, breaking out and freedom from some kind of prison.

Meaning: A time of turmoil and destruction as you try to understand how you could have been mistaken about a situation or person.

Keywords: Anger, grief, depression, loss of appetite, insomnia.

The old is destroyed to make room for the new.

XVII. Star - January 20th - February 18th / Aquarius

Principle of Hope

Intuitive understanding of cosmic connections meets principle of sacrifice and inner trust in harmonious laws. Thus, the real experience of dreams and dream worlds are led through unintentional trust in a self-protected determination of our fate.

Hebrew: He = window

Astrological attribution: Aquarius

This card represents a beautiful process. Cosmic inspiration of the highest nature is received and made manifest on the material plane.

Meaning: Being fulfilled and inspired by life. A reminder to follow our dreams and that which gives us the most inspiration.

Encouragement is now being given. You have had testing times in the past, and now is the time to move forward with renewed hope.

Key words: Hope, inspiration, trust in the self, connection to universal intelligence.

XVIII. Moon - Pisces

Principle of the Unconscious

Endless depths of our unconscious side meet primal fears and longings. The world of deception also has phases of growth in store.

Hebrew: Qoph pronounced (Kopf) = back of the head

Astrological attribution: Pisces

The Moon card is often seen as illusion and deception. It represents the unknown, fear, and things that we do not want to face.

Meaning: The divinatory meaning can be somewhat negative, but we have to deal with it in a positive way.

It is bringing to our attention the need to deal with negative or destructive subconscious patterns. It suggests a time when something in your life is not as it appears to be, a situation that is deceiving.

The Moon also represents your shadow self, or your subconscious or hidden self.

Key words: Wrong turn, illusion, burning off karma, struggle with the subconscious, difficult testing.

XIX. Sun - Sun

Principle of Light

Through its extremely positive power, it strengthens all life and growth processes and leads us to knowledge and reconciliation with the dark side.

Hebrew: Resh = The head

Astrological attribution: The Sun

The Sun card = Freedom, success and creative growth.

Effects of the sun path are: Child-like freedom of creation, transformation of the bodies emotional programming, spiritual expansion, a more balanced personality.

This card symbolizes direct conscious awareness as compared to working through our subconscious nature symbolized by the Moon Card.

The Sun is the source of life and represents success and abundance.

Key words: Highly creative energy, awareness, fulfilled love relationships, wisdom, spirituality, transformation.

XX. Aeon - Fire

Principle of New Age

This card heralds a redeeming and awakening process or cycle, where all experiences and forces are united in a new form of life.

Hebrew: Shin = Tooth

Astrological attribution: Libra

The Aeon card stands for big changes. A decision which has a major impact on your life: relationships, career, lifestyle, spiritual, near death, the birth of the new self, new beginning, seeing the bigger picture.

This card means a new area and a new calling. It tells you that you are released from old boundaries, and it aligns to pre-destination. It brings you blessing and gives you support from higher powers.

Key words: renewal, end of an era, begin of a new era, judgement, spiritual calling, rebirth, birth, reincarnation, change, final outcome, revelation

XXI. Universe - Saturn

Principle of Totality

This card symbolizes the perfection. It contains the fruit of our goals as the climax of our vocation and our existence as the summit of our innermost perfection.

Hebrew: Tau = Cross

Astrological attribution: Saturn

This card represents both the collapse of the universe and its new beginning.

It means the completion of the great work, the passage of the soul back to God, and the completion of the spiritual journey.

This card is the Omega of the tarot, with the Fool being the Alpha.

The major arcana of the tarot represents the entirety of the universe and the spiritual journey.

It can mean the completion of a project. Your efforts are finally paying off.

This is the last card of the major arcana, it closes the circle which began with the Fool.

The great task has been brought to completion.

Key words: journey, world travel, possibilities, study, wholeness, totality, fulfillment, goal achievement, success, moving, time travel

Ace of Wands - Principle of Creativity

Fire signs - Aries, Leo or Sagittarius

Always new energy of some kind. Creative urge to realize something new. Amazing power will rock your life which you can use for new projects and beginnings in all areas. Your healing energies are strengthened. You will feel restlessness and the need to make external changes. You have enough courage to take a risk and initiate new challenges. 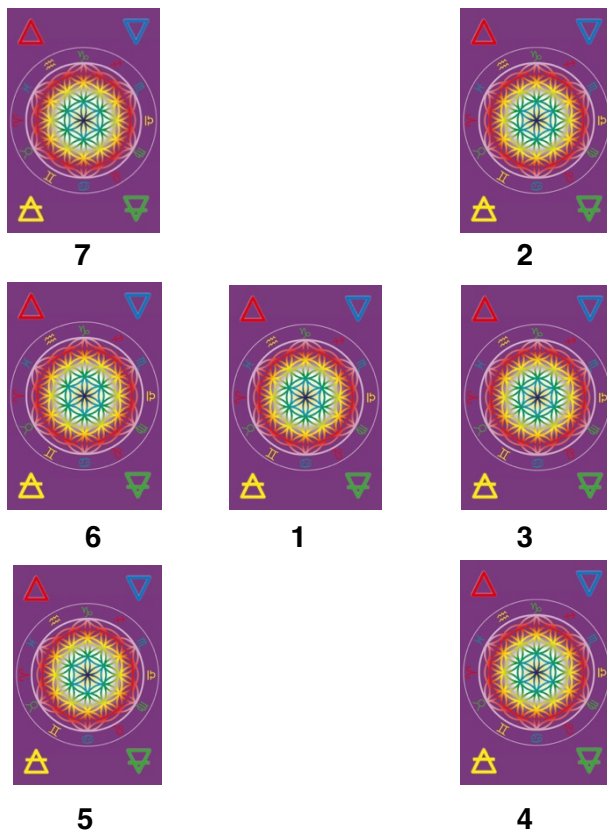

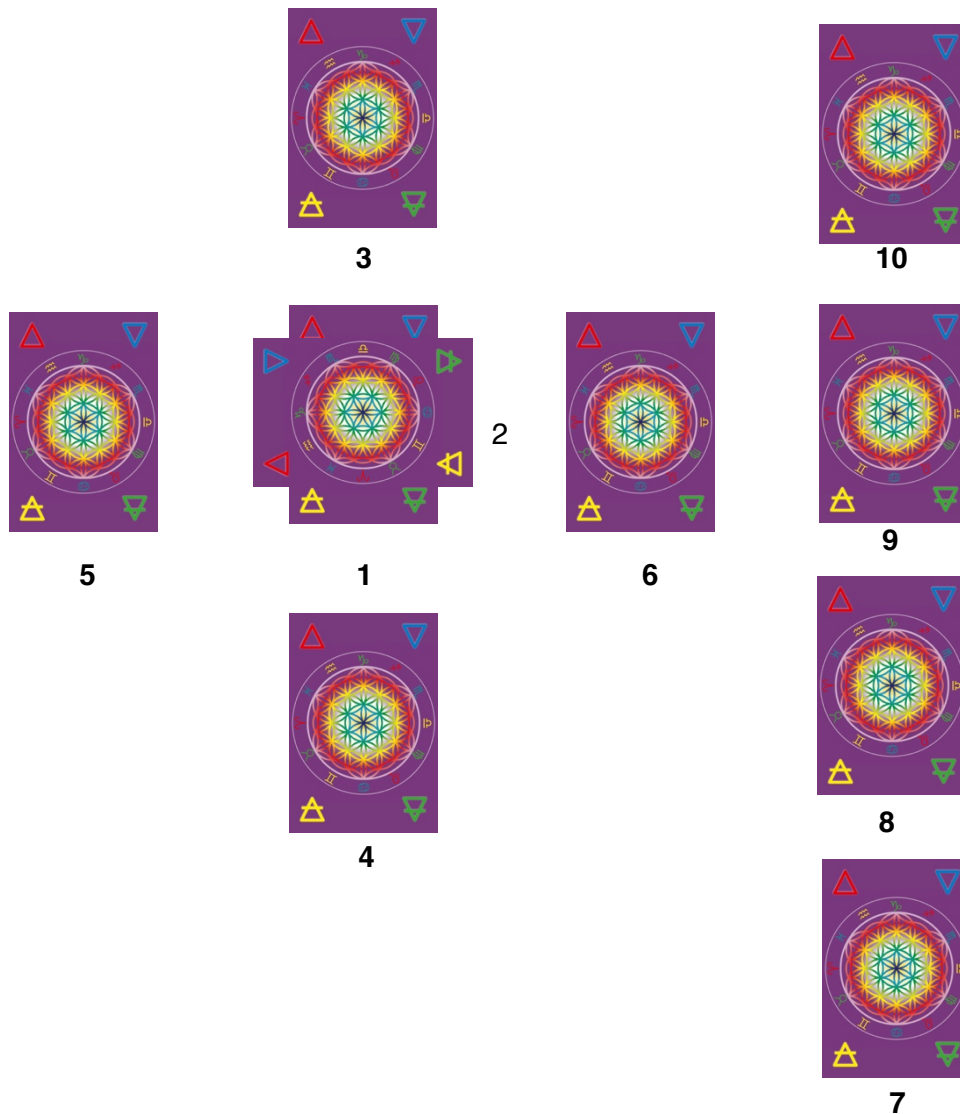

For your daily practice I would suggest pulling a daily tarot card. In general, it is easier to learn first about the major arcana. They are the foundation of the minor arcana anyway.

Please take into consideration that elements are very important, they can strengthen or weakening. For example:

- Fire and air are friendly and active
- Water and earth are friendly and passive
- Fire and water they weaken each other
- Air and earth they weaken each other
- Fire and earth strengthen each other but are neutral
- Water and air strengthen each other but are neutral

- Princesses are earth
- Princes are air
- Queens are water
- Kings are fire
